With the engine not running and the ignition in the off position, disconnect the ground (negative) battery terminal and connect a test light in line with the ground cable and the battery negative terminal. If the light illuminates, that indicates a draw on the system. For this test, you can also use the voltmeter set in the "amps" position.

For charging batteries you want minimal voltage drop between the alternator output and the battery bank.
