This is a relatively simple job, but be sure to check for any intersecting oil passageways in your engine and make sure that adding a plug won't disrupt oil flow. In some applications, including Pontiac V-8, some plugs use a tiny hole, around 0.030-inch, to provide a small stream of oil to help distributor gear or timing gear longevity, so make sure your replacement matches the factory oiling.

Rear cam plug installation on the Ford Y-Block engines dictates that it not be installed so deeply that it actually interferes or contacts the rear of the camshaft. Besides the obvious wear issue that can occur at the face of the cam plug, detrimental wear at the rear side of the cam thrust plate can become evident or in a worst case situation, the thrust plate itself can break.

These plugs are thin and sometimes rust through, allowing engine coolant to leak. When this happens, the old freeze plug must be removed and replaced with a new one. The installation of engine block heaters also requires the removal of a freeze plug. The problem is, these plugs are pressed in and are recessed in the block.

Core plugs are also known as expansion plugs, welch plugs and sealing discs - a point to remember when buying one. The plugs are set in various places around the engine block and cylinder head. Their purpose is to seal holes left in the block and head when those components were cast. They also provide weak points which can give way under the pressure of expanding coolant if the engine freezes ...

If your vehicle doesn't have a block heater port, you'll have to have a freeze plug removed in order to install a block heater. On the Toyota 1.8L pictured, the empty port is located on the driver's side of the engine, below the brake master cylinder.

Examine the threads in the engine, if they are dirty; clean them with a thread cleaning tool. Installing the New Spark Plugs Step One. If necessary, set the gap on the new spark plug before installing it. In the past, it was necessary to use a gapping tool to make sure the gap in the spark plugs was the correct size.

3 Carefully begin threading the spark plug into the engine by hand, turning it clockwise. This is called

“seating the plug.” You have to do it by hand or you run the risk of starting the plug crooked and ruining the threads on the plug or the threads in the spark plug hole in the engine.

Stop the engine and put a timing light on the #1 spark plug. Restart the engine. Adjust the timing by rotating the distributor housing by very small amounts. Be sure to follow the instructions specific to your vehicle which you located before replacing the distributor - as noted above, these instructions will vary from vehicle to vehicle.
